Dear Church Family,

Grace and peace to you my brothers and sisters in Christ! We have been having a very busy summer and I am excited to tell you about one of our latest adventures – the Youth Mission Trip to Washington DC. Our team has been planning and preparing for this trip since February, and our departure date finally arrived on July 30th. Trinity UCC partnered with St. John's UCC in Boalsburg, and twenty of us left on Sunday afternoon for a five-day mission trip to serve people affected by poverty and homelessness in our Nation's capital. Trinity UCC sent five youth and five adults. The youth that traveled included Kylie Auman.

Andrew Boob, Sara (there is no "h" in my name!) Floray, Maddie Gooch, and Harrison Reish. Adults making the trip included Rick Arnold, Pastor Dave Downer, Terri Downer, Carol Frazier, and Jane Pifer. We had a great time and were very busy. Each day was a new adventure as our host organization, Youth Services Opportunities Project (YSOP), sent us to different ministry projects throughout the city. Our groups worked sorting, cleaning, and displaying donated furniture and household items, preparing cooking and serving meals in several different kitchens and shelters, sorting and distributing groceries, and doing yardwork for seniors through a program that helps people remain in their homes longer. [Please visit our Facebook page or go to www.trinitycentrehall.org for more pictures of our experiences.] Throughout the week we learned that homelessness has many causes and very often the people experiencing extreme poverty are not that different from us. Our YSOP hosts challenged us to find ways to take some of the lessons we learned back to our home town and look for ways we can serve others in our own communities.

One site we visited worked exclusively with men and women without homes or jobs. Their multi-faceted program worked with individuals to help them view their condition as temporary, and provided a roadmap for achieving independence. One of the counselors gave us some insight to how they succeed in this. He said, "Compassion without expectations, is enablement." They help each person understand that what they are going through is simply a temporary condition. They ask each person they help to make a commitment to work toward self-improvement. It begins with giving each person dignity, treating them with respect, and taking the time to listen. Before they can enter the process, they must ask for help. Once this happens, they begin working to obtain basic necessities, like getting an identification card, obtaining health insurance, and getting medical help to treat both physical and mental illnesses. While the numbers are small compared to the overall population, the program succeeds seventy-five to eighty percent of the time and people graduate from the program with jobs and a place to live as a result.

Even though I have worked with people suffering from poverty and homelessness for many years, I learned a great deal on this trip. Giving assistance to people without a holistic plan to better themselves may improve their circumstances for a short time, but to really help someone it takes a commitment. Just like it does the individuals you're seeking to help, both parties must commit to a plan and be willing to participate for the long run. This will require a lot of hard and work and patience – lots of patience. I hope to use some of this new-found wisdom in our own community. Yes, it will take time and might result in frustration and even failure sometimes, but Christ never promised us easy work, just meaningful work.

We learned and experienced a lot on this trip. We got to know each other better and see how we handle ourselves in stressful situations where we're hot, tired, and uncomfortable. With all the youth I've worked with over the years, I've never been more impressed that I was with the young people from Trinity UCC. They worked hard, never complained, volunteered to help at every opportunity, and were courteous and respectful to everyone they met. I feel very good about the future of our church with young men and women like Kylie, Andrew, Sara, Maddie, and Harrison leading us.

TREE DEDICATION IN LOVING MEMORY OF BETTY AND TED HARTLEY




