Dear Members and Friends of Trinity UCC –

Wow, that went fast! December 1, 2019, marked my five-year anniversary as your pastor. What a blessing it has been to be a part of such a caring and active church family. Perhaps for the first time in my life, I look forward to each and every day and am continually amazed at the countless blessings God bestows on our church and community.

I have previously talked of focusing our efforts on being a more visible presence in our community, creating meaningful worship opportunities, and practicing radical hospitality to both our church family and other members of our community. We will continue to focus in these areas of course, but this year I would like to issue a different sort of challenge to you. I'd like to challenge all of us to filter everything we see, feel or hear through the lens of God's love. See others, and the world around us, with God's perfect 20/20 vision in the year 2020. I'd like to encourage all of us to read and repeat to ourselves frequently, "I will be a vessel of God's mercy and grace, slow to anger, quick to forgive, an instrument of peace in all situations. I will allow God's presence to fill and flow through me, such that grace and truth, God's true nature, are revealed." This challenge is not much different from what the Apostle Paul asked of the people of Thessalonica when he said, "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Being mindful of God in all our daily routines and activities is a form of prayer and is what Paul intended when he said to "pray without ceasing." Something else that will hold true even more so in 2020 is that we respect one another. Being hospitable to one another, our guests and visitors, and community members is more than just a good idea, it's fundamental to our faith. In a divisive time in our nation, my prayer is that in Christ, we will be one. That doesn't mean we have to agree on everything, it simply means we treat everyone with courtesy and respect.

Reflecting back on 2019, it was a good year in that many of our ministries continued successfully. We continued to serve the people of Penns Valley and beyond through your generous giving and some successful fundraising. The Centre County Child Development and Family Council (CDFC) continues to hold before and after school care in our church. In the summer months, Trinity UCC is home to one of the CDFC Summer Day Camps for children in grades one through five. Summer days at the church are filled with the laughter and joy of children as they play on the church lawn or in the gravel parking lot. We are also able to partner with the YMCA and other churches to have nutritious lunches served to them as part of a county-wide summer lunch program. Volunteers and donations are always welcome for this program.

One of the highlights for me last year was hosting the combined Centre Hall Council of Churches Lenten services. Each Wednesday evening, from Ash Wednesday through Holy Week, the people of Centre Hall and beyond came together to sing, pray, and worship together. We had wonderful attendance this year, to include some new events during Holy Week that we had never participated in before. For instance, we had our usual Maundy Thursday soup and bread meal with Holy Communion, a Good Friday event for area children and adults to include a "Stations of the Cross" worship service and then a "Cross Walk" where several of us carried a large wooden cross through the streets of Centre Hall, stopping to pray at designated areas for the people in our community. That evening we held our annual Tenebrae service or "Service of Shadow", a very meaningful
