Dear Members and Friends of Trinity United Church of Christ -



We are fast approaching the end of 2020, and I won't mince words – I'll be glad to see it go. I remember beginning this year with such enthusiasm and issued a challenge we could turn to for hope and inspiration. In my February 2020 newsletter I said: "I'd like to challenge all of us to filter everything we see, feel or hear through the lens of God's love; to see others, and the world around us, with God's perfect 20/20 vision in the year 2020." When I wrote this, I had no idea what the year would bring, not the least of which was a worldwide pandemic that shows no signs of slowing, and a bitterly divided country. In hindsight, after experiencing a year that has left so many of us feeling tired and beaten down, I can't help but wonder and worry about what 2021 might look like. So again, I return to the challenge of 2020 and the call to see all things through the lens of God's love. It is still relevant

and more necessary than ever.

The Apostle Paul wrote about our calling in Ephesians: "I therefore...beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all." I believe all professing Christians should take this message to heart. These virtues of humility, gentleness, patience, and love are not optional. Neither is the desire to be unified as one in the Spirit. These are the things that bind us as a community of believers serving a common purpose. They form the foundation of our faith and give evidence of our life in Jesus Christ. Every one of us need to find some way of reminding ourselves of this calling each and every day.

In light of the difficulties and suffering of this past year, we must not lose sight of the hope living within us. God never promised us a trouble-free life, but God <u>did</u> promise us salvation and life through Jesus Christ. To borrow a term from the late Father Henri Nouwen, we are *God's Beloved*. Throughout history, humankind has faced difficult times. Remaining focused on our calling can help us stay focused and grounded as individuals and communities. Despite what life in this world brings, we are and will remain God's Beloved children.

My prayer for all of us, our church, our community, and our nation, is that we will see and experience our lives as a passage to the greater life and freedom found in Jesus Christ. May God bless and keep all of us and our families safe. May we continually pray for and care for one another. And may the peace that surpasses all understanding be with us and within us as we (finally) conclude 2020 and look toward 2021.

JOB OPPORTUNITY

Trinity UCC is seeking a Church Secretary to fill an upcoming vacancy. The Church Secretary provides administrative support to the Pastor. This position requires strong attention to detail, the capability to communicate well, the ability to exercise tact and confidentiality, and exceptional organizing skills. This position is multi-faceted – tasks range from preparing church printed materials, maintaining accurate records, and staying current with church activities and events. The Church Secretary also acts as a liaison between the church, its members, and the community.

Office hours will be spread over four days per week. Standard hours are 20/week although this will vary depending on the season and other needs. Most workdays will be spent in the church's office; some work may be possible from a remote site with internet access. Office hours will be coordinated with the Pastor and kept constant as much as possible.

A high school diploma is required; an Associate's or Bachelor's degree is recommended. Administrative office skills and experience is desired. This is an hourly position paying \$10 - \$12 per hour, depending on qualifications and experience.


