

#### **Good Words for Great Souls**

We've heard the word "unprecedented" used often the last few years, generally, in the context of how we live in "unprecedented times". I recently had the privilege of officiating a funeral service for a long-time Penns Valley resident who passed away four days prior to her 101st birthday. As I reflected on her long life and prepared her memorial service, I gained a new perspective on the word "unprecedented."

Mary was born just as WWI was ending and a global pandemic was devastating the world. When Mary was around ten years old, the stock market crashed and sent the country into a decade of depression, unemployment, and famine. Her father lost her job during this time, which is what brought them to Penns Valley, where the family took up farming. She was married three months after Pearl Harbor and probably listened to war news on the radio, much as my grandparents did. She lived through many other deadly diseases, wars, droughts, floods, and famines. She lived in an age when air travel became possible and watched in wonder when a few decades later, the first men landed and walked on the moon. She experienced new conveniences such as indoor plumbing, mechanized farm equipment, and washing machines, all of which made her life just a little bit easier.

There is so much more, but I think you get my point. Unprecedented times? I don't think so. Difficult times? Certainly. But the human spirit will endure, and our role as Christ-followers remains unchanged, to comfort the afflicted and provide assurance of the hope that lives within us through Jesus Christ our Lord.
