How do you know God exists? It's a question I'm sometimes asked, particularly by those going through a difficult time in their lives. It seems much easier to believe in God when things are going well for us. We trust in the words of reassurance the Bible offers and imagine that God will protect us from all harm, and this makes us feel comfortable and secure. But then something comes along that rocks our world. It can be most anything—the death of a loved one, a disaster, an illness or injury, and suddenly our faith is shaken. We turn to heaven and ask, "Why God?"

This month, I'll be concluding a five-week sermon series on finding hope in the Bible. Summary of 22 September Consistory Meeting

Treasurer's Report: The total General Fund income for September 2021 was \$8,893.28. The general fund expense for September 2021 was \$6,752.57. Pastor's Report: Pastor Dave continues to send emails, cards, and makes calls to members. Property Committee: Exterior paint on the wooden trim of our church has faded much sooner than expected. Sherwin Williams has offered to give the paint needed for repainting but has not offered to do the job; The committee has recommended no longer hanging the Christmas candles from the ceiling lights in the sanctuary. The safety of hanging the candle lights and possible damage to the antique ceiling lights is the concern.
Previous Business: The committee will continue to work on internet in the sanctuary, parts that are needed are on back order; The Diaper Ministry is going well, the first distribution was September 25. New Business: Church office hours are now Tuesday and Thursday 11:30 a.m. to 2 p.m., and Wednesday 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.; A new board member is needed for Interfaith human Services, meetings are the third week of every month.; Penns Valley Christmas of Hope will use our church again for the collection of Christmas gifts.
